- All entry tags must be securely tied or taped to the articles
- The MAS will do its utmost to return all antiques in the condition in which they were submitted, however all antiques are exhibited at the owner's risk.
- Plastic sleeves or bags, etc., may be used to display items which could be damaged by attaching tags.
