- All articles must be complete and ready for use unless otherwise specified.
- Only new and up-to-date articles will be considered for judging

- 1. Any craft item using "shell art" a craft made of shells of any size or colour
- 2. Any craft item using "feathers" ie. wall décor-can be any colour-use your imagination-check out websites
- 3. Any article using the Origami technique
- 4. A cover or cozy for your iPad or smart phone (knitted, crocheted or sewn)
- 5. Bath bombs or bath salts-displayed in a jar-please list ingredients used
- 6. Handmade fashion accessory—any technique—ie. jewellery
- 7. Any article made by recycling an old vinyl record
- 8. Any article using the paper quilling (not quilting) technique
- 9. A small article of leather tooling, ie. wallet
- 10. Best dressed doll-set of handmade doll clothes, any size, displayed on a doll
- 11. A recipe holder
- 12. Decorated picture frame—any technique
- 13. Handmade pin cushion
- 14. 3 handmade greeting cards, any occasion, each with a different technique (no envelopes)
- 15. Decorative or functional homecraft using a mason jar and/or lid
- 16. Welding-NEW-a free-standing farmer-using nuts, bolts, screws, scrap metal, not to exceed 12"
- 17. An article of needlework made on plastic canvas
- 18. A small article made from recycled wood
- 19. A wood carving-small article, ie. fish, bird, etc.
- 20. A small article using the woodburning technique, max. 12"x18"
- 21. Any Diamond Art kit picture-max. 18"x20"

FINE ARTS & CREATIVE WRITING

- 22. Creative writing—a written piece, by hand or on the computer, 1 page, on "GOATS" - mounted on Bristol board, could have a decorative border
- 23. Penmanship—hand-written, 8 lines of a favourite poem, mounted, could have a decorative border
- 24. An original poem, hand-written or printed on computer, of the Fair theme "GOATS", mounted, could have decorative border
- 25. A completed page from an adult colouring book using pencil crayon, mounted on Bristol board
- 26. A completed page from an adult colouring book using markers, mounted on Bristol board
- 27. Any drawing using black pencil, coloured pencil, pastels, or charcoal, topic "GOATS"
- 28. A painting—oil or acrylic, max. 18"x24" your own choice of subject
- 29. A painting-watercolours, max. 18"X24" your own choice of subject

- 31. Valentine's Day—any craft item featuring hearts
- 32. St. Patrick's Day-any item to help celebrate St. Patrick's Day

- 35. Father's Day-celebrate Dad's Day with a craft item
- 36. Canada Day-a small craft item to celebrate Canada's birthday
- 37. Thanksgiving—any craft item with a Thanksgiving theme
- 38. Hallowe'en-any craft item to celebrate Hallowe'en
